Birding by Electric Shuttle: If the weather is reasonable we will push the limits of the season in our open-sided electric shuttle. It seats six and is an excellent way to take in the views without walking.

Birding Walk: Our naturalist conducts a n hour-long walk around local lanes looking for migrating birds.

Tour Weekapaug in Electric Car: Take in the views and lovely lanes of Weekapaug in our open-air electric car. Half-hour tour.. room for five passengers.

Walk to Weekapaug Overlook: Join Mark on a short walk to Weekapaug overlook. He will bring our spotting scope and point out landmarks such as Watch Hill, Fishers Island, Montauk Point and Block Island. He might also spot some of our seasonal bird species.

Trustom Pond Bird Walk: The US Fish and Wildlife property features well-maintained trails that meander through native grasslands, upland forest and eventually to a large coastal pond. Viewing platforms afford fine views of waterfowl and sweeping vistas of the beach and marshes.

Mercury Transit of the Sun: Have a look through our solar telescope and see the sphere of mercury as it crosses the face of the sun. This is a relatively uncommon event.
